It has been an exciting time at Millner School this fortnight, teaching and observing students and staff engaged in explicit teaching, particularly for Maths with the help of our support staff. Car park and road safety

I am reminding all parents to drive slowly at our car park, park in approved areas and monitor your children getting in and out of cars during pick up and drop off time. It is important that you model good road crossing behaviour for our students to follow as well.

Our School goals for 2024:

These are our 2 goals for the year!

By the end of 2024, all students attending school more than 60% will show growth of 1 stage in their Meaningful Maths assessments

Our teachers and support staff have successfully completed their first Maths sprint this week, resulting in at least 70% students who have attended school 4 or more days, moving a stage upwards. This is fantastic news to celebrate. We have started on the second round of sprints this week.

By the beginning of Term 4 in 2024, there will be a growth of 15% in student survey responses to the question 'There is an adult at my school who cares about me and knows me well'

Our staff have started explicitly teaching our students about what it means to have a trusted adult at school, and how this adult can help us through tricky issues at school.

These goals have been created using the responses from surveys completed this year, our own student achievement data in 2023 as well as staff feedback. We feel confident that by addressing and achieving these 2 goals, we will positively impact our student outcomes.




